How To Partner with Missionary Families

with one mind striving side by side for the faith of the gospel

Our prayer is that we will be a blessing to our missionaries, not a burden. Our desire is to lessen their burdens through prayer and practical support. Every missionary family is different and has unique needs for engagement; ask missionaries how we can best partner with them. Give them a list and ask, "here are some ways we have helped others; which of these ideas might work for you?".

Create a wish-list for each missionary family. Sometime during the year set up a gift tree with cards listing missionary needs; have people in the church select a card and provide the gift. Implement a missionary needs board, with an ongoing list of items or services which will help support their ministry.

We have identified six categories of care to consider when partnering with a missionary along with a list of suggested actions. Don't expect to do everything on the list; your relationship with a missionary should be continuous and long-term. Please pray about ways you can be more involved.

3 John 5-8 Beloved, it is a faithful thing you do in all your efforts for these brothers, strangers as they are, who testified to your love before the church. You will do well to send them on their journey in a manner worthy of God. For they have gone out for the sake of the name, accepting nothing from the Gentiles. Therefore we ought to support people like these, that we may be fellow workers for the truth.

Be aware of security in the host country. Send notes and cards, for birthdays, anniversaries, and other special occasions. Mail care packages and include items for all ages. Call them on the phone or make zoom calls. Add missionaries to your church mailing lists. Invite local missionaries to church events, family events, meals, and other activities. Meet with local missionaries for lunch or coffee. Visit the missionary. Ask ahead of time how you can bless them. When the missionary visits provide a basket with gift cards, snacks, books, small presents.

Visit the missionary and provide maintenance for their facilities. Do yard work or repairs to their home. Set up an amazon registry for the missionary and family. Arrange for help with legal issues: wills, POAs, taxes, funerals, health care, financial planning.
